Jhumpa Lahiri (1967-) is a Bengali American author. She was born in London of Indian parents and grew up in Rhode Island (USA). She completed her higher education in Boston University. Though she has lived outside India most of her life, it is India, or rather the idea of India in the minds of expatriate Indians that forms the substance of her short stories and novel. Her writing brings out the sense of nostalgia and yearning in her characters through a fluid Chekovian description of their simple lives and ordinary actions. Lahiri's debut short story collection, *Interpreter of Maladies* (1999), won the 2000 Pulitzer Prize for Fiction, and her first novel, *The Namesake* (2003), was adapted into the popular film of the same name. She was born Nilanjana Sudeshna, which she says are both "good names", but goes by her nickname Jhumpa. Lahiri is a member of the President's Committee on the Arts and Humanities, appointed by the former U.S. President Barack Obama.
