



How can I find out who the hiring manager is for a position?

When applying for roles on Michigan's career site, you may find the hiring manager's name or title within the job posting itself. If not, here are a few ways to identify them:

- **Explore the College of LSA's website:** Go to [website address] and navigate to the department related to the position. You can often find faculty and staff listings with names and titles.
- **Use LinkedIn:** Search for individuals with relevant titles within the department at the University of Michigan.
- **Network:** Reach out to your professional connections. Someone in your network may work at the university or know someone who does.
- **Request informational interviews:** Connect with people in the department to learn more about the team and potentially identify the hiring manager. Keep in mind that hiring managers may sometimes be unable to grant all requests for informational interviews.
