What is Credit Recovery:	<ul> <li>A shortened version of a failed course to recover credit only.</li> <li>Recovered courses are taken for a Pass/Fail (P/F) grade only.</li> <li>Recovered course grade does not replace the failed course grade.</li> <li>Recovered courses will not be accepted by the NCAA Division I or II core standards.</li> <li>Recovered course may be re-evaluated for admissions by colleges / universities</li> </ul>
What is Grade Replacement?	<ul> <li>Repeats an entire course that has been failed.</li> <li>The initial course must have been taken in Fall 2015 or after.</li> <li>Repeated course shall replace the previous course grade.</li> <li>Credit toward graduation is only earned once, regardless of the number of times the course is repeated.</li> <li>If the course has an associated EOC / NCFE / CTE post-assessment, the higher of the two exam grades will be used in the calculation of the final grade.</li> <li>If the repeated course is failed, both courses, each with the grade of F, remain on the transcript and are calculated in the grade point average (GPA).</li> </ul>
