Summer Concerts readiness

- **Summer Concert 9th July**

Health and safety arrangements are in place as is First aid cover.

The hall is free from 11.30 for setting up. The organisers of this need to know the exact number of singers expected for the evening performance.

Madeleine has the ticket sales organised. 62 tickets have been sold so far and it is hoped to reach about 100 audience. 100 programmes have been produced accordingly.

As in the Spring concert there is to be no bar, no staging and a 10 minute interval to reduce expenditure.

There was a discussion of more commercial approaches to selling of tickets and several ideas were put forward to be investigated so that it can be discussed at the next meeting in more detail. Sylvia and Tim are to investigate this further.

- St Peters update

It is hoped there will be a smooth transfer to St Peter's in September. There is to be a concert on November 12th of the Faure requiem and a carol concert to include Wholenotes in a date yet to be confirmed in December. There needs to be some clarity found about parking availability for regular rehearsals and concert dates.

AOB

- Salma to investigate a possibility of funding for providing a piano for St Peter's for their use and ours in rehearsals.
- There was a discussion about attendances by the members. It was felt that at the AGM in October there should be some mention of the need for better attendance then has been the case recently. The date has been changed to October 3rd.
- Salma was also tasked with looking for funding for our concert with Wholenotes at Christmas. It was thought that Surrey Heath Show fund might be a good source.
- The quiz (a fund raising event) looks likely to take place in November. Perhaps local supermarkets could be approached for prizes for a raffle.
- Keith is to email the members to remind them of the new £150 annual membership fee. Members can pay annually, monthly or termly.
