 - appreciate and embrace cultural and racial diversity;
 - forge strong bonds and rapport with your teachers and peers.
4. Your CCA participation, achievements and leadership roles throughout your years in Pei Hwa will be tracked and recorded. In your graduating year (i.e. Sec 4 or 5), all your co-curricular involvement and contribution will be computed (in accordance to the MOE LEAPS 2.0) and a finalised Co-curricular Attainment (i.e. Excellent / Good / Fair) will be awarded accordingly. The level of attainment will be converted to a bonus point(s), which can be used for admission to Junior Colleges/ Polytechnics/ Institutes of Technical Education.
5. On 10 January 2026 (Saturday), you and your parents will get a chance to find out more about the CCAs. We will also conduct a briefing to inform you and your parents regarding MOE LEAPS 2.0, the CCAs offered in our school, as well as the CCA allocation exercise on the same day.
