HMCY Sports Complex Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct applies to all visitors of the Houston Methodist Cypress Sports Park ("HMCSP"), including athletes, spectators, coaches, officials, and staff. By entering the premises, you agree to comply with this code for the safety, enjoyment, and well-being of all guests.

Any dangerous, inappropriate, or illegal activity may result in immediate removal from the premises, a temporary or permanent ban, and potential legal action.

General Policies

1. **Minors:** All minors under the age of 18 must be accompanied and supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
2. **Trespassing & Solicitation:** Trespassing and soliciting are strictly prohibited on HMCSP grounds. This includes unauthorized entry onto fields or in buildings, as well as the sale or distribution of goods, services, or promotional materials without prior written consent from HMCSP management.

3. **Right of Refusal:** HMCSP reserves the right to refuse entry to or remove any individual who violates this Code of Conduct or poses a threat to the safety and well-being of others.
4. **Liability:** All athletic activities and spectating are done at your own risk. HMCSP is not responsible for any personal injury, property damage, or lost or stolen items. We advise all visitors to secure their belongings and be aware of their surroundings.
5. **Parking:** All vehicles must park in designated parking spaces (Lot E). Parking in fire lanes or other non-designated areas is prohibited and may result in towing at the owner's expense. HMCSP is not responsible for lost or stolen items from vehicles.
6. **Trash:** All guests, teams, and spectators are responsible for properly disposing of their trash. Teams are expected to clean up their designated areas after each use. Failure to do so may result in a loss of future field access.
7. **Schedules:** All teams, guests and spectators must honor and be respectful of their scheduled time slots, strictly adhering to the designated start and end times. Repeated violations will result in the forfeiture of their reservation

Prohibited Items & Conduct

For the safety of all visitors, the following items and behaviors are strictly prohibited on HMCSP grounds. This list is not exhaustive, and HMCSP management reserves the right to prohibit any item or conduct deemed unsafe or inappropriate.

Prohibited Items

1. Weapons of any kind (firearms, knives, explosives, etc.), whether concealed or open carry.
2. Illegal drugs, drug paraphernalia, and alcohol.
3. Tobacco products, including cigarettes, cigars, electronic cigarettes, and vaporizers.
4. Glass containers.
5. Pets or other animals (with the exception of leashed registered service animals).
6. Fireworks, flares, smoke bombs, and any other incendiary devices.
7. Generators, fuel heaters, or open-flame grills (charcoal and propane).
8. Drones, remote-controlled cars, or similar devices.
9. Scooters, hoverboards, segways, skateboards, inline skates, and bicycles.
10. Confetti or Silly String.
11. Any substance used to mark the grounds, such as spray paint, powder, or duct tape.

12. Air horns, amplified sound devices, laser pointers, or laser pens.
13. Metal cleats.

Prohibited Behavior

1. Any behavior that endangers the safety, well-being, or peace of participants, visitors, volunteers, or staff. This includes illegal, abusive, harassing, or offensive conduct.
2. Verbal or physical threats, intimidation, or fighting.
3. Vandalism or defacing of HMCSP property.
