## **Backstory**

His quirk was still basic, combat trials he proved resourceful, using barriers and makeshift tools to beat stronger opponents. When it came time for hero schools, he was accepted into Ketsubutsu Academy High School, where his creativity stood out. In his entrance exam, while others fought for villain points, he racked up rescue points by shielding classmates and more using his panels.

After graduation, Kuwamori pursued pro hero work. He wasn't famous, but he made a name for himself in rescue operations and urban disaster response, where his ability to quickly create barriers, escape routes and fend off threats saved countless civilians.
