- o Hold an active Tennessee teaching license minimum of bachelor's degree in Special Education and experience with behavior techniques or be willing to enroll in an educator prep program to obtain Special Education endorsement

Job Purpose Statement/s:

The Special Education Behavior Classroom Teacher for the program promotes and develops successful learning for students who are eligible for IDEA services, manages an assigned caseload, maintains regular communication with those students, their parents, and appropriate staff members and is responsible for development, revision and implementation of IEP's. The Special Education Behavior Classroom Teacher effectively supports the education of students who exhibit behavioral infractions that could potentially harm him/herself, other students, or staff members.

Position includes but is not limited to:

- o Providing direct instruction services to students with disabilities (SWD)
- o Acting as case manager for SWD including writing Individual Education Plans and documenting progress on goals
- o Coordinating evaluations for student services
- o Attending to the personal care needs for SWD
- o Supervising teaching assistants as they provide services and care for SWD
- o Experience and expertise in student behavior management and collaborative problem solving
- o Ability to provide leadership to staff in areas of specialization
- o Excellent interpersonal skills to consult effectively with teachers, administrators, and parents, in a variety of settings
- o Ability to train and/or assist staff in physical management of students in crisis
- o Maintain integrity of confidential information relating to students, staff, or district patrons
- o The ability to work harmoniously with others
- o Knowledge of age-appropriate teaching methods, state curriculum framework, education and special education law and appropriate instructional subjects.
