On the back of this flier, you will find a recipient and budget list to assist your young shoppers in the store. Please fill out the name section for anyone your child will purchase a gift for and bring this list with you. Please note that shoppers may purchase one to ten gifts.

Please send your children with small bills (\$1, \$5, and \$10) to pay for their gifts and a reusable shopping bag in which to take them home. We are also collecting canned food items for Samaritan House at the door.

HOLIDAY STORE SHOPPING GUIDE:

- 1. Make your shopping list by adding a recipient name to each line (limited to 10) and assign a budget. For Grandparents, Siblings and other recipients, please include the person's name (Grandma Anne, and not just Grandma). This ensures the right gift and gift tag will be assigned.
- 2. As your child selects gift, they (and their volunteer helper) will write what the gift is on the line next to each name, and the dollar amount assigned to each gift. The shopper and helper will add up the total cost before reaching the cashier to expedite the check out process.
- 3. After checking out, the shopper and helper will proceed to the wrapping station where all gifts will be wrapped and a gift tag attached with the name provided.
- 4. Please send your children with small bills (\$1, \$5, \$10) to pay for their gifts and a reusable shopping bag in which to take them home. Please bring a canned food item to donate to the Samaritan House (a collection box will be at the door).
