Vision, Mission & Goals

Course Description:

In kindergarten through fifth grade all students participate in general music class taught by a certified music educator. The class introduces age-appropriate music fundamentals including beat, rhythm, melody, expressions, pitch, form, and composition. Musical goals are attained through singing, performing on instruments, connecting, responding and creating through various music philosophies. Contained within their K-5 education, students experience a live performance by the South Dakota Symphony Orchestra, an introduction to playing recorder, a drumming ensemble, and two choral performances presented in second grade and fifth grade.
