Hours:	During May (couple of hours to organise rotas/ card readers/raffle tickets/ paperwork); organise the team of raffle ticket sellers (rotas) During the festival 31st May - 8th June After the festival (admin and money counting, evaluation)
Venue/location:	A set venue TBC
Activities:	Before the festival (May)- working closely with volunteer coordinator: - Prepare raffle tote bags for sellers: clipboards, cash float, raffle tickets stubbs, pens, maps of the venues, card readers) - Prepare induction meeting with raffle ticket sellers - Establishing list of events to sell tickets and number of sellers required for each event - Prepare raffle admin sheets - Get cash from the bank (to confirm with Moira) and prepare and manage float for the sellers - Organise the set up of card readers for volunteers sellers
	During the festival: - Organise collection and drop off of raffle tote bags for sellers - Making sure tote bags are always fully ready for



	raffle ticket sellers - Be point of contact for raffle ticket sellers (via text or phone call) - Manage card readers distribution and collection - Manage raffle admin rota and paperwork - Manage cash floats - Securing cash - Keeping safe all tickets stubbs and prepare them for raffle draw on the 10th of June
	After the festival: - Evaluation
Skills and Experience required:	 Able to take responsibility of your work and work under no supervision Confident talking and managing a small group of volunteers Able to be polite and courteous Comfortable handling cash and card readers Able to handle few easy administrative tasks Able to work with Excel Willing to work as part of a team and to cover agreed hours Able to handle sensitive situations with discretion Keep fluid communication with volunteers, other festival colleagues and the volunteer coordinator

Expenses provided:	We will reimburse reasonable amounts that volunteers have to spend on travel and childcare if agreed in advance and on production of receipt when volunteering for us

- Work at all times in accordance with volunteer policies and procedures
