

HOW TO WRITE A REVIEW FOR AMAZON

NB: You do not need to purchase a book on Amazon, but **you must have an Amazon Account** if you want to post a **Review** on an **Amazon website**.

Post your Review on **Amazon.com**, or on **Amazon.co.uk** (if you live in the UK).

Book 1, STEP 1. Enter **the legend begins (a legend of the English)**

Click on the book photo on the left (see below) to open a new, dedicated page.
