GM Report:

- Eric would like to increase our line of credit by \$5,000 to pay bills and expenses for club.

- Hannah moved to Fargo, we will be in need of a new Bar Manager.
- Cathy Thompson should be contacted to see if there is interest in being Bar Manager again.
- Conrad briefly reviewed Minnesota State Liquor License requirements. Different rules apply to clubs and our percentage of food sold could be drastically reduced than we previously thought. Eric not in attendance, unable to know status on this topic.
- Dave mentioned he noticed at an out of town bonspiel they were able to have beer and other alcohol sold by donation. He will talk to Eric about this.

Membership:

- Eric J presented dues sheet showing 3% increase in dues amount.
- Payment plan should be shown available in 4 payment increments starting in November and ending in February.
- CVV Code needs to be added to Credit Card Portion.
- No early pay discount will apply if the payment plan portion has been selected.
- Skips name should be removed from league box and should be made into a check mark about which league is preferred.

Marketing:

- Adopt A Rock Program is live on the website and social media.
- Jordan will set up Facebook group for subs and teams to find members as part of a club opening marketing plan as we are getting closer to curling season.

- Other posts leading up to opening will include promoting Community Ed Class, Learn to Curls (if we have them scheduled), and Start of Season Open House as we get more details.

Finance:

Strategic Planning:

- Eric will activate Curling Club Manager for this season beginning in September.

Kick Off Party:

- Dave will consider combining the Start of Season Open House with the Community Ed Bonspiel, however this conflicts with Deer Hunting Opener. Spiel could be moved to a weekday if needed.
- Dave would like to do a Membership Drive and raffle off a membership.
- Junior Curling will have a booth, league chairs could help promote their leagues, logo pins and Dave's pizza would be available, looking at a 4 hour window.

Board Welcome Kit:

- Eric added feedback from last meetings notes.
- Document is now 21 pages and includes the bylaws, what to expect at meetings, Safesport information, financial reports, contact sheet, hierarchy chart and job descriptions.

SWCA Membership Inquiry:

- Amanda sent in application.
- Discussion of different bonspiels the club could host: Stu & Dave will work on 5 and under spiels for the club to host, Jamie is interested in hosting an open spiel – an email thread will be developed to continue to discuss spiel options.
