

Several ways how to construct a message for Chat GPT to get concise information

1. **Use a direct and specific question:** Instead of asking a general or open-ended question, try to ask a specific and direct question that will help you get the information you need. For example:
 - "Can you provide me with a list of the top 10 AI companies in the art industry?"
 - "What are the main applications of AI in the music industry?"
 - "I'm trying to decide between two special effects software programs for my movie project. Can you provide me with a comparison of Blender and Houdini?"
 - "What are the most common uses of AI in the business world?"
 - "I'm a teacher looking for ways to incorporate AI in my lesson plans. Can you suggest some resources or ideas?"
 - "How is AI being used to improve healthcare outcomes?"
2. **Provide context for your question:** If you are asking chat GPT a question, make sure to provide enough context for it to understand the context of your question. This will help it provide a more relevant and accurate response. For example:
 - "I'm a beginner in the art industry and I'm looking for some inspiration. Could you provide me with a list of famous artists who use AI in their work?"
 - "I'm a musician looking to incorporate AI into my compositions. What are some good resources or software programs to use?"
 - "I'm producing a small budget film and I'm trying to decide between two animation studios. Can you provide me with a comparison of the services and prices offered by Blender and Houdini?"
 - "I'm starting a small business and I'm trying to decide between two AI-powered customer service software programs. Can you provide me with a comparison of Zendesk and Freshdesk?"
 - "I'm a teacher looking for ways to use AI to personalize learning for my students. Can you recommend any good resources or ideas?"
 - "I'm a healthcare professional looking for ways to use AI to improve patient outcomes. Can you provide me with some examples of successful implementations?"
3. **Use keywords:** If you are looking for specific information, try using keywords in your message to help chat GPT understand what you are looking for. For example:
 - "What are the latest developments in AI-powered art software?"
 - "Can you provide me with a list of the top AI-powered music composition tools?"
 - "I'm looking for information about the use of AI in movie special effects. What are some good resources or case studies to read?"
 - "I'm interested in using AI to improve my business's marketing efforts. What are some successful case studies or examples I can learn from?"

- "I'm a teacher looking for ways to use AI to improve student engagement. What are some good resources or ideas?"
 - "I'm a healthcare professional looking for ways to use AI to improve patient diagnosis and treatment. What are some good resources or case studies to read?"
4. **Use the appropriate tone:** Make sure to use an appropriate tone in your message. If you are asking for technical information, a formal tone may be more appropriate. However, if you are asking for general information or making a casual request, a more casual tone may be more appropriate. For example:
- "Hello, I'm a student working on a research project and I was wondering if you could provide me with some information about the use of AI in the art industry?" (formal)
 - "Hey, I'm just wondering if you know of any good resources for my research about AI in the art industry (informal)
5. **Be specific about what you need:** Make it clear exactly what you are looking for in your message. For example, instead of saying
- "I'm looking for information about AI in the entertainment industry", you could say "I'm looking for a list of the top 10 AI-powered special effects studios" or "I'm looking for a summary of the main applications of AI in the movie industry".
6. **Avoid using jargon or technical terms:** If you are communicating with someone who is not familiar with a particular subject, avoid using jargon or technical terms that they may not understand. Instead, try to use simple and clear language that is easy to understand.
7. **Use examples to illustrate your point:** If you are trying to explain a concept or idea, using examples can help make it more clear and understandable.
- For example, instead of saying "AI is being used to improve business operations", you could say "AI is being used by companies like Amazon to analyze customer data and improve the efficiency of their supply chain operations".
8. **Use action verbs:** Using action verbs in your message can help make it more specific and clear. For example,
- instead of saying "I was wondering if you have any information about...", you could say "Can you tell me..." or "Could you provide me with..."
9. **Use bullet points or numbered lists:** If you have multiple points or pieces of information that you need to convey, consider using bullet points or numbered lists to organize them. This will make it easier for the person you are chatting with to understand and respond to each point. For example:

- "I'm looking for information about the use of AI in the education industry. Could you provide me with a list of the top 5 AI-powered learning platforms, along with their features and pricing?"
