## **Year 8: German**



## Task title: Find out more about German speaking countries





- Find out about the internationally-famous German export, Haribo. Why is it called Haribo and where is it produced in Germany? What is the history of Haribo? Note down any other information such as how much is sold every year. Can you write your opinion of Haribo in German?
- Read a German poem and tell your class about it.
- Research a famous German/Austrian singer, musician or music group and write 10 facts about them in German. Write your facts down – find a picture of your chosen musician to include too.
- Go on Youtube/Netflix. Find a favourite film or programme and change the audio settings to German. You might like to start with Peppa Pig or Friends in German. Write down what you have watched and make a note of any German words you recognise.
- Find a topic or grammar point you are studying this year and explore it in more detail using (see link below). Explain the grammar point or topic that you have chosen and include some examples and a quick quiz!

Create a poster, leaflet or PowerPoint to show your research. Include illustrations / photos to support your findings.
