

Monitoring Audit sub-Project

The **Monitoring Audit sub-Project (CT MON)** is part of **QA activities** and is undertaken by the **Monitoring Organization** appointed by the **Sponsor** and independent of the **Clinical Trial team/Sponsor/CRO**.

The **Monitoring Organization** acts as the main line of communication between the **Sponsor** and the **Investigator**.

The **Monitoring Audit** is the act of overseeing the progress of a **Clinical Trial** and ensuring that it is conducted, recorded, and reported in accordance with the **protocol, SOPs, GCP**, and **regulatory requirements**. One **Monitoring Audit** covers only one **Investigational Site** and the **Investigational Site** is one of the main characteristics of the **sub-Project**.

The **Monitoring Audit sub-Project** is triggered by:

- *Pre-Trial Monitoring Audit Notification*
- *Initiation Monitoring Audit Notification*
- *Regular/Planned Monitoring Audit Notification*
- *Triggered Monitoring Audit Notification*
- *Close-out Monitoring Audit Notification*

After registration of the Notification, the **Monitoring Audit sub-Project** becomes an active topic in the **Enriched Email Client**.

Below are presented all **significant events** that can be selected by a designated **regulatory project person**, nominated **Assistant**, or **Agent** when sending or receiving **enriched email messages** during the realization of this type of **Corporate Project**. The designated **regulatory project person**, as the **designated follower** of the **enriched emails** for the specific project, also receives copies of all **enriched email messages** sent by the **Assistant** or **Agent** and is forwarded to all **enriched email messages** received by the nominated **Assistant** or **Agent**.

Automatically generated **enriched email notifications**, sent or received, cannot be selected and are presented here for illustrative purposes only.

Also, not all **significant events** need to be selected, in fact, only the selection of **significant events** whose selection leads to a new **project activity** is mandatory, as this enables the progress of the **Corporate sub-Project**.

The procedure model can be easily modified by adding, deleting, or changing *milestones*, *activities*, and *significant events* to suit particular needs/requests.
