

Unit 5: Breakfast with Veterans

In order to better understand the perspective of military veterans, you will have the opportunity to spend an hour with a veteran from the Cupertino community.

Task: In groups or half-groups, you will prepare questions for a video recorded interview with your veteran, which you'll do after a breakfast hosted by the Cupertino Rotary in the Student Union. Following the interview, you will edit your materials to be shared with the veteran, his or her family, and the Cupertino community.

Before the interview

Your group will have very little information about your interviewee in advance. This will require you to prepare a set of questions that serve as a jumping off point for the interview but are not the only questions you will ask.

Create a Google Doc of questions for your interviewee.

Once you have your interviewee's brief RSVP bio form, you will research the dates and conflicts your interviewee served during and add to your questions. You will have time to research in class.

During the interview

Meet at the cafeteria at **8:15 am on Wed, Mar. 4th**. You will help with setup and escorting veterans to your assigned room where your interview will take place. Each of your group members will have [a specific role](#).

You will have breakfast then move to your interview location.

In addition to the interview, your veteran will also have his or her portrait taken, and you will have a photo taken with the veteran.
