Admission Requirements	Candidates and Admission Conditions Requirements for master's program applicants: a) Applicants must have graduated or received a graduation recognition decision for a bachelor's degree (or equivalent or higher) in a relevant major; for the research-oriented track, a 'Good' graduation classification or higher is required, or scientific publications related to the field of study. Applicants participating in the articulated bachelor's to master's program of the University of Economics and Law. b) Applicants must have foreign language proficiency at Level 3 or higher according to the 6-level Foreign Language Competency Framework for Vietnam. "In cases where applicants have not yet met the foreign language proficiency requirements stipulated in Clause 3, Article 5 of Circular No. 23/2021/TT-BGDĐT dated August 30, 2021, regarding the Master's Admission and Training Regulations, and other conditions specified by the University of Economics and Law in its annual Admission Scheme, an entrance foreign language proficiency assessment shall be conducted as prescribed.

	Foreign national applicants, if enrolling in master's programs taught in Vietnamese, must achieve Vietnamese proficiency at Level 4 or higher according to the Vietnamese Language Competency Framework for foreigners or must have graduated from a bachelor's program (or equivalent or higher) where the language of instruction was Vietnamese; and must meet the second foreign language requirements as prescribed. c) Applicants must meet other requirements of the standard training program issued by the Ministry of Education and Training and the regulations of the training program.

PART 2: TRAINING OBJECTIVES, CAREER OPPORTUNITIES, AND FURTHER STUDY	
Program Objectives	3.1 General Objectives To train learners to have in-depth expertise in civil law and civil procedure, skills in analyzing and resolving legal situations regarding civil matters and civil procedure, along with professional responsibility and autonomy in study and work, enabling them to work in state administrative agencies, enterprises, educational institutions, and research institutes. 3.2 Specific Objectives Knowledge Objectives To provide learners with a system of in-depth knowledge about civil legal life, enabling them to, on one hand, advise all subjects on legal conduct in civil life; and on the other hand, conduct research to contribute to the refinement of legal doctrine in the civil field. The specialized areas that the program is designed to focus on are the fundamental contents of property law and contract law, especially common contracts in civil life, as well as other specific legal issues in the civil field. With this special design, the master's program in Civil Law and Civil Procedure aims to

	train high-level experts in theory and practice; possess creative, independent research capabilities; have the ability to guide scientific research and professional activities; and be able to identify and solve scientific and practical problems. Skill Objectives Through writing essays, in-class discussions, and solving practical case studies, the program equips students with the ability to creatively apply theoretical and practical issues of legal life, as well as to analyze and apply current legal regulations in the field of Civil Law and Civil Procedure in specific situations. They will be able to leverage their own experiences and develop necessary skills in assessing issues, analyzing situations, and proficiently processing information. Based on this, learners will be able to make strategic decisions to resolve emerging issues in the practicalities of legal life and dynamic civil interactions. Autonomy and Responsibility Objectives After the training process, research-oriented master's students can determine the legal and ethical limits and standards in professional activities by grasping the guiding legal ideologies in the civil and civil procedure fields to behave appropriately; simultaneously, possess the ability to self-organize work in group research and independent research to form lifelong learning capabilities.

Additionally, master's degree holders can hold management positions at various levels in the organizational management apparatus of State agencies, judicial bodies, or practice law or work in enterprises of different economic sectors.
