Instructional Resources & Materials will be described as any book, material, or resource used in the classroom or available in the school library.

As the governing body of the school District, the Board is legally responsible for the selection of Instructional Resources and Materials..

Instructional Resources and Materials will be recommended for acquisition by the Chief Academic Officer, in consultation with the administration, teachers, and students, based upon educational value, age appropriateness, and alignment to the board-approved curriculum. Final decision on acquisition will rest with the Board. All Instructional Resources and Materials will be aligned with the District's academic standards and support the district's educational objectives.

All textbooks, library resources, and other instructional materials will be available for inspection by students' parents/quardians.
