

# 02.1 | Write a "How Might We...?" Question

## **Overview**

In this activity, you will use the "How Might We" template to first create an impact statement and then transform it into a "How Might We...?" question for your user.

### **Instructions**

#### Part 1: Set Up

- 1. Make a copy of the "How Might We" Template.
- 2. Refer back to your user and be sure that you have your user insight statement on hand for reference as well.

### Part 2: Complete the "How Might We" Statement

- 1. Based on you user insight statement, fill out the "How Might We" template:
  - First, write down the problem you are trying to solve.
    - Example: Students buy water on campus. There is too much plastic water bottle waste on campus.
  - Then write an impact statement.
    - Example: To reduce the number of plastic water bottles on campus.
- 2. Next, rephrase the problem into a "How Might We" statement.
  - Examples:
    - How might we... discourage students from purchasing water on campus?
    - How might we... promote the use of water bottle filling stations on campus?
    - How might we... promote the recycling of water bottles on campus?
