

ABSTRACT TITLE SHOULD BE WRITTEN IN TIMES NEW ROMAN, 14pt, UPPER CASE, BOLD STYLE, SINGLE SPACING, JUSTIFIED ALIGNMENT

Author 1¹, Author 2², etc – Authors should be written in Times New Roman, 14 pt, Sentence case, Bold style, Single spacing, Justified alignment.

Author affiliation should be written in Times New Roman, 10 pt, Sentence case, Regular style, Single spacing, Left alignment. Following information should be included: Name of the department /institute/ laboratory, Name of the Head institution, City, State. An example of author affiliation:

Body Text should be written in Times New Roman, 12 pt, Sentence case, Regular Style, Single Spacing, Justified alignment.

Page margins: Left – 3,0 cm; Right – 2,5 cm; Top – 2,5 cm; Bottom – 2,0 cm.

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- Affiliation – 10 pt;
- Free line – 10 pt;
- Body text – 12 pt;
- Free line – 10 pt (if applicable);
- Acknowledgements – 10 pt (if applicable);
- Free line – 10 pt (if applicable);
- References – 10 pt (if applicable);
- Free line – 10 pt (if applicable);
- Reference subject – 10 pt (if applicable);
