Historic Preservation:

Diana reviewing movement of historic houses:

- Developers seek to move the historic houses at the SE corner of Speedway and Euclid. The city is negotiating with Goodman over the NW corner.
- Goodman is holding out for a better price as real estate prices increase
- No current demolition permits on that corner, neighbors on the block are concerned

TEP 128 KV Power Lines

- Signs around "No Tall Poles"
- A number of different routes proposed, some through historic neighborhoods including Feldmans (Helen & Euclid)
- City and TEP are in negotiations
- FNA has joined a neighborhood coalition to bury the lines
- Line siting hearing committee scheduled for July 25th

- Sub station at Lester (by Banner)

Campus Community Relations Committee

- Part of University, adjacent neighborhoods participate
- Years ago, it was an effective problem solving space however now it serves more as an information exchange
- Keeps us in contact with other neighborhoods (example: CCRC came together to rally against Peak Campus housing on NW corner of Speedway and Euclid.)

- Brought ACLU to Tucson, active in Democratic party, made great community gains
- Honors each year, the person that has gone above and beyond in neighborhood
- Beau Peterson is this year's recipient
