Math	Literacy
In math, we will begin Module 5: Addition and Subtraction Number Stories and Counting to 20. Students will act out math stories with up to 5 objects. For example, a student might use his/her fingers to represent a story about students and say, "3 children were playing. (Shows 3 fingers.) 2 more children came. (Shows 2 more fingers.) 3 and 2 make 5. Five children are playing now."	This month we will continue with Domain 5: Habitats. We have introduced 2 of the 5 habitats: Woodland and Pond. Students will learn more about the next three habitats: Desert, Ocean, and Farm. Students will identify 1 plant and 2 animals for each habitat. Please continue to work on identifying letter names and its sounds. The 8 letters that students will be assessed on will be: m, a, t, d, o, c, g, i
