- 3) The Squadron denied the Home Assn. request to pay 1/3 (1800\$) for the electrical upgrades needed at the Post. The Squadron believes some of the parking lot debt should be paid down first and that the income from the new gambling machines should be established before any electrical upgrades are made.
- **4)** Randy Everett made a motion that all cash from all son's events be counted within 3 days of the event by at least 2 Son's members, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Gordy Parker. 10 yays. 2 nays. The motion passed.
- 5) The Commander expressed concern about the Squadron's income verses the amount of annual donations. Discontinuation of the 500\$ Cash Raffle was discussed. New fundraisers ideas were solicited.
- 6) Union High School cheerleader Ally Colombo made a presentation and request for donation to her Cheerleader competition in Florida. Virgil Weideman made a motion to donate 500\$ to help cover the cost of the competition, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Gordy Parker. All in favor. No objections. The motion passed.
- 7) Virgil Weideman made a motion to donate 500\$ to the Knights of Columbus Tractor Ride/Food Drive, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe Colombo. All in favor. No objections. The motion passed.

**Closing Comments:** The Commander asked for any additional new business, at which none was reported at that time, he asked for a motion to adjourn. The motion was made to adjourn by Larry Pohlmann, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Joe Colombo. Motion passed. (All in Favor - No Objections.).
