Know Before You Go

UPDATED: 4/29/26

- What to bring...
 - Pit table and chairs
 - Energy-efficient pit lamp
 - 50-100' extension cord
 - Power strip
 - EZ Canopy (optional)
 - *You must have your tents staked down in all 4 corners with heavy duty pegs
 - FM radio to tune into our SBRN live broadcast on over-the-air FM 87.9
 - *An FM radio will be important. We cannot turn up our sound system too loud because of our neighbors.
 - Sunscreen/bug spray (optional)
- We use RCTScoringPro.com as our scoring system
- MyLaps transponder (2 or 3 wire), the new pro version (black) works also
- Please provide your transponder # when registering (NO EXCEPTIONS!)
- Each race entry will receive 5 tickets per class to enter into the door prizes of your choice. On Saturday extra tickets will be sold at \$5 per ticket or 3 for \$10
- We have a full service concessions trailer for breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- No grilles or open flames allowed. No cooking devices on our electric. You can bring food and drinks, or order out/in if you must. We appreciate your patronage of our concessions trailer.
- We do not support adult beverages at our facility. If you feel you must, keep it in your pits and limited to after the race day.
- Check out the [track entrance and parking area](#). Keep out signs are only to keep out vehicles—canopies/pits can be set up beyond keep out areas. Keep vehicles out of those areas. We will assess the pit areas on Thursday morning.

- Trailers and trucks will not be allowed on the grass below turns 1 and 2
- You may spend the night at the track but there are quality hotels and campgrounds less than 10 miles from the track.
- No AC units or air compressors will be allowed on our electric
- Please be kind, if you plan to use a generator—make sure it's quiet or away from everyone's pit area.
- We have an air hose attached to an industrial strength air compressor and a water hose by the concessions trailer
- We have hand washing stations by the concessions stand and hobby shop
- Portable toilets are located behind the hobby shop
- Our location in town requires us to keep speaker volume reasonable. Please bring an over-the-air radio to pick up announcements and race coverage--there is no excuse not to hear announcements.
- We also broadcast live on our [SBRN YouTube Channel](#) so share with your friends or watch from your pits.
- We do not offer guest WIFI.

Rules and Procedures:

- We pride ourselves in offering a fun, family-oriented atmosphere, please read our [Track Guidelines and Expectations](#) prior to arriving.
- We will be using Qualifier Points during the 3 qualifiers. Your best two runs will seed the mains. Your worst qualifier will be thrown out.
- You can arrive and sign up Saturday morning...it just means you will only have 2 qualifiers.
- If you sign up Friday, you do not need to sign up again on Saturday.
- If there are weather delays, we can run the entire program on Saturday. Sunday is the rain date but we will do everything humanly possible to complete the program on Saturday.
- If you need to withdraw from a class or race or leave early, please let us know so we are not waiting for you.
- No one is above marshaling. If you can't marshal when required (physical limitations, in the next race, etc). YOU must find a worthy replacement.
- Visit our [website for class specifications/rules](#). We expect our drivers to follow a code of honesty and help in policing each other.
- Please be kind and helpful to our tech guys, they are racers too.
- 21.5 USGT spec motor must meet [Motiv/Gravity RC specs](#). Anything to advance the fixed timing beyond the tolerance will be deemed illegal.
- A racer in any class found with an illegal motor will forfeit the rest of their race day in that class.
- 17.5 Stock Sprint, 17.5 Stock EDM and 21.5 Late Model—expect to have your ESC inspected for blinky mode at any time. ESC found not in blinky will not be able to run that qualifier or main.
- Batteries must be at or under 8.44 on our volt meter.

- Have fun. Have a good time. Enjoy your day. Talk with friends. Make new friends. Smile and laugh—a lot. Enjoy the hobby you love. Most importantly—relax and have fun.
