V. Discussion Items

A. **Strategic Plan:** Ms. St. Joy reviewed the schools Strategic Plan from 2021-2025. The principal discusses how Hutchinson's strategic plan aligns with APS's strategic Plan. Some of the school's strategic priorities are as follows:

1. Reduce barriers to school attendance and decrease chronic absenteeism.
 2. Build teacher capacity in core content areas, particularly Math, ELA, Science and STEM Education
 3. Recommend high-quality staff for vacant positions that arise
 4. Improve the percent of students achieving at proficient and distinguished level on Georgia Milestones Assessment.
 5. Implement STEM engineering and design program model that leads to obtaining STEM school certification by 2025
- ii. Ms. St. Joy also outlined the school's strategy to accomplish our priorities. They are as follows:
1. Implement rigorous and real-world interdisciplinary projects, units, and PBL's through STEM
 2. Obtain STEM certification by 2025
 3. Implementation of PBIS program to promote a positive school culture
 4. Build upon and maintain business and education partnerships (Delta and Northwestern Mutual)
 5. Provide targeted professional learning opportunities focused on the implementation of Standards and STEM
 6. Implement intentional vertical and horizontal alignment collaboration throughout the school

7. Increase Math/Science/STEM/GIFTED endorsements to support STEM implementation
8. Monthly calendar of school events.
9. Build parent capacity to understand student needs through in-person Parent Meetings and Academic Parent Teacher Teams (APTT)
