

CJHS Option Registration Grade 6

2023-2024 School year

Students will choose 6 options (one must be a music class). The school year is split into 3 sections - Trimester 1, Trimester 2, Trimester 3. Students will take two options each trimester (which lasts approximately 12 weeks). One option will be on Monday/Wednesday and the other option will be on Tuesday/Thursday.

Please choose carefully. Schedule changes will not be done. The options you choose on the form are the options you will be registered into.

Registration will open on May 31, 2023 at 5:00 pm. The registration form link is in an email from Candace Atwood, on our website and on our Facebook page. The form will close on June 9. At this time, Mrs. Atwood will assign option classes to any student who did not register through the form.

Music Classes: ALL grade 6 students must take one of the following:

Brass Band: Cost \$15

Trimester 1 Mon/Wed

In grade 6 band students will learn the basics of playing a wind instrument. These include: Trumpet, Trombone, Baritone and percussion.

There are other instrument choices available for students who have previous music experience like piano lessons. We will also learn the practical application of reading music.

General Music: Cost \$15

Trimester 2 Tue/Thur OR Trimester 3 Tue/Thur

In Grade 6 General Music, you will participate in various musical activities including (but not limited to) percussion, choral, instrumental etc.

Woodwind Band: Cost \$15

Trimester 1 Tue/Thur

In grade 6 band students will learn the basics of playing a wind instrument. These include: Flute, Clarinet, and Saxophone.

There are other instrument choices available for students who have previous music experience like piano lessons. We will also learn the practical application of reading music.

The following classes are available on a limited basis:

Band: Cost \$15 rental fee per trimester (Free if you have your own instrument)

In grade 6 band students from the Brass and Woodwind band will combine together into Band so the students will get the full band experience to help prepare them for grade 7 band. We will share our music with concerts and festival performances here in Cardston and in Lethbridge.

Beading 6: Cost \$5

Come learn how to turn beads into pendants, earrings, pen covers etc!

Blackfoot 6: Free

This course will introduce students to the basics of Beginning Blackfoot Language with a focus on the Blackfoot alphabet's 13 symbols: a,h,i,k,m,n,o,p,s,t,w,y and glottal stop indicated by an apostrophe ('). Other areas of focus will be identifying sounds, pronunciation of names, colors, numbers, greetings, and kinship words. Learning the Blackfoot language creates better communication, bonding, identity, unity and respect within family and others.

Board Games: Cost \$5

Come learn some new games as well as some classic games while you play with your friends.

Home Ec - Cooking 6: Cost \$20

Learn basic cooking skills and how to use basic kitchen equipment.

Industrial Arts 6: Cost \$25

Basic woodworking skills and wood turning on a lathe. Come choose from a variety of projects including bowls, candlesticks, etc. Have an idea you would like to try? Share it!

Native Culture 6: Free

The Blackfoot Culture is the backbone of our cultural beliefs, customs, values and identity. In order to remain strong like our ancestors did for generations we need to learn and maintain our native ways of life. Learning our Blackfoot culture from stories told by our elders, grandparents, and parents. Students will learn by attending Medicine Pipe Ceremony, Annual Sun Dance, Pow Wows, Name Giving, Transfer of Headdress / War Bonnet, Transfer of TeePee Design, dancing, drumming and other social gatherings.

General Art: Cost \$20

Students will be introduced to various mediums and techniques through many projects. Students will get a chance to learn about drawing, sculpting, painting, and other art forms throughout the term. Students do not require any experience in art, just a passion to create and learn.

Science Exploration 6: Cost \$20

This class focuses on hands-on science activities and projects in order to help students gain understanding of scientific concepts and theories. Some of the projects will be presented as competitive challenges while others are more experiential or experimental.

Softball & Sports Movies: Cost \$5

Come learn tips and techniques while learning to play the game of softball! The balance between being outside playing the game and watching sports movies will be based on weather.

Option Schedule

- All grade 6 students have a mandatory Music class (listed on the second row so you can see when they are offered).
- Not every option is available every Trimester. Here is a list of what is offered when so you can make a plan.
- Different classes have different enrollment limits, so some classes will fill faster than others.
- When registering you will be choosing ONE option from each column.
- **You cannot choose the same option twice** (Example: If you choose cooking in Trimester 1 you cannot choose it again).
