Middle School 7th Grade

- **History:** Western Civilization using *All Ye Lands: Origins of World Cultures* (World-Cartography)
- **Literature:** Classic literature (corresponding to the time periods and including a story of a saint)
- **Philosophy:** *Traditional Logic 1: Intro to the Science of Right-Thinking* (Memoria Press)
- **Writing:** *IEW Level B Year 1*
- **Science:** Earth Science

Middle School 8th grade

- **History:** US History using *Sea to Shining Sea: The Story of America* published by Catholic Textbook Project
- **Literature:** American Literature (corresponding to the time period and including a “great book”)
- **Philosophy:** Logic 2: *Harry Stottlemier’s Discovery* and *The Fallacy Detective: Analysis and Debate*
- **Writing:** *Lost Tools of Writing*
- **Science:** Physical Science

High School 9th Grade:

- **Theology:** Old Testament: *Didache Series: Understanding the Scriptures*
- **Philosophy:** Ancient Philosophy(1st semester) and Metaphysics (2nd Semester)
- **History:** Ancient History: *These Were the Greeks, These Were the Romans*
- **Literature:** Ancient Literature through classics
- **Aesthetics:** The Beauty of Language: Analytical and Rhetorical Writing

High School 10th Grade:

- **Theology:** New Testament: *Didache Series: Understanding the Scriptures*
- **Philosophy:** Human Person (1st semester) and Psychology (2nd Semester)
- **History:** Medieval History: *The History of the Church*
- **Literature:** Medieval Literature through classics
- **Aesthetics:** Art (Studio and Appreciation) and Music Appreciation with a Medieval focus.
