Task 1:

Writing: Find out [what inspired Oliver Jeffers to write 'Here We Are'](#).

Imagine you find an alien who has just crash landed on Earth... write a 'Welcome to Planet Earth' picture book to tell the alien all about Planet Earth.

Think about the different people on earth, the foods we eat and things we like to do. You could even talk about school!

As a class you could even create a short video using Adobe Express (formerly Spark) to tell the alien all about Planet Earth.

Task 2:

Writing: Create a poster on [J2E5](#) on how we can take care of Planet Earth.

Think of small changes we can all make that could make a big difference such as using less plastic, recycling, planting more trees and using our cars less. Use the Internet to help you with ideas.

Task 3:
