MATH:

nice cheery voice and everything starts off with "Hi friends!" Make sure your child has scratch paper or a white board. It's engaging and the video will ask them to participate.

FREE. go to the khan academy website and make an account, download the app on your phone or tablet. What I like about this is you can assign assignments to your child. If you know he/she struggles in say addition, assign that to them.
