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Resources for Adults with Medicaid

As of August 28th, 2023, Medicaid in Missouri will no longer cover gender-affirming care. Here are some resources for adults struggling to pay for gender-affirming care. This document will be updated as we learn about resources.

If you already have a prescribing clinician, talk to them about your concerns and options. The implementation of this law and the resources available are a complicated moving target. Your clinician should be able to talk with you about the most affordable formulation and pharmacy for your particular type of hormone(s).

Resources for Minors

As of August 28th, 2023, minors (anyone under age 18) cannot be prescribed or administered gender-affirming puberty blocking medication, hormone therapies, or surgeries per Missouri law. There is a legal case pending that will determine if this law stands. Although the law allows for minors who are already receiving gender-affirming hormones or puberty blockers to continue receiving that treatment, MU Health Care has made the decision to stop prescribing gender-affirming hormone therapy or puberty blocking medications to minors, even for patients who had already established that care.

If this ban applies to you or your child and you already have an established relationship with a doctor, your first step is to reach out to your doctor to discuss their plan for ongoing care.
