## **Twitter Tips and Tricks:**

- 1. Choose a twitter handle (name) that fits you or describes what you do.
- 2. Be sure to upload a picture and fill in your bio right away so that other educators know you are a "real" person.
- 3. YOU choose what appears in your Twitter Stream by who you choose to follow.
- 4. Follow people you want to learn from, aspire to be, etc
- 5. Once you get setup utilize a Twitter organizer such as TweetDeck or Hootsuite
- 6. You will get out of Twitter (or any social media) what you put out there. Get connected and interact.

### **BENEFITS OF USING TWITTER**

Twitter is like a virtual staffroom where you can catch up with your PLN. It's a place where educators can find advice, give advice, find great links, share work, and engage in general musings about education.
