Exodus

Exod.25.10 - "And they shall make an ark of acacia wood; two and a half cubits shall be its length, a cubit and a half its width, and a cubit and a half its height.

Exod.25.11 - And you shall overlay it with pure gold, inside and out you shall overlay it, and shall make on it a molding of gold all around.

Exod.25.12 - You shall cast four rings of gold for it, and put them in its four corners; two rings shall be on one side, and two rings on the other side.

Exod.25.13 - And you shall make poles of acacia wood, and overlay them with gold.

Exod.25.14 - You shall put the poles into the rings on the sides of the ark, that the ark may be carried by them.

Exod.25.15 - The poles shall be in the rings of the ark; they shall not be taken from it.

Exod.25.16 - And you shall put into the ark the Testimony which I will give you.

Exod.25.17 - "You shall make a mercy seat of pure gold; two and a half cubits shall be its length and a cubit and a half its width.

Exod.25.18 - And you shall make two cherubim of gold; of hammered work you shall make them at the two ends of the mercy seat.

Exod.25.19 - Make one cherub at one end, and the other cherub at the other end; you shall make the cherubim at the two ends of it of one piece with the mercy seat.

Exod.25.20 - And the cherubim shall stretch out their wings above, covering the mercy seat with their wings, and they shall face one another; the faces of the cherubim shall be toward the mercy seat.

Exod.25.21 - You shall put the mercy seat on top of the ark, and in the ark you shall put the Testimony that I will give you.

Exod.25.22 - And there I will meet with you, and I will speak with you from above the mercy seat, from between the two cherubim which are on the ark of the Testimony, about everything which I will give you in commandment to the children of Israel.

Psalm 52

Ps.52.1 - Why do you boast in evil, O mighty man? The goodness of God endures continually.

Ps.52.2 - Your tongue devises destruction, Like a sharp razor, working deceitfully.

Ps.52.3 - You love evil more than good, Lying rather than speaking righteousness. Selah

Ps.52.4 - You love all devouring words, You deceitful tongue.

Ps.52.5 - God shall likewise destroy you forever; He shall take you away, and pluck you out of your dwelling place, And uproot you from the land of the living.Selah

Ps.52.6 - The righteous also shall see and fear, And shall laugh at him, saying,

Ps.52.7 - "Here is the man who did not make God his strength, But trusted in the abundance of his riches, And strengthened himself in his wickedness."

Ps.52.8 - But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God; I trust in the mercy of God forever and ever.

Ps.52.9 - I will praise You forever, Because You have done it; And in the presence of Your saints I will wait on Your name, for it is good.

Romans

Rom.9.1 - I tell the truth in Christ, I am not lying, my conscience also bearing me witness in the Holy Spirit,

Rom.9.2 - that I have great sorrow and continual grief in my heart.

Rom.9.3 - For I could wish that I myself were accursed from Christ for my brethren, my countrymen according to the flesh,

Rom.9.4 - who are Israelites, to whom pertain the adoption, the glory, the covenants, the giving of the law, the service of God, and the promises;

Rom.9.5 - of whom are the fathers and from whom, according to the flesh, Christ came, who is over all, the eternally blessed God. Amen.

Rom.9.6 - But it is not that the word of God has taken no effect. For they are not all Israel who are of Israel,

Rom.9.7 - nor are they all children because they are the seed of Abraham; but, "In Isaac your seed shall be called."

Rom.9.8 - That is, those who are the children of the flesh, these are not the children of God; but the children of the promise are counted as the seed.

Rom.9.9 - For this is the word of promise: "At this time I will come and Sarah shall have a son."

Rom.9.10 - And not only this, but when Rebecca also had conceived by one man, even by our father Isaac

Rom.9.11 - (for the children not yet being born, nor having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works but of Him who calls).

Rom.9.12 - it was said to her, "The older shall serve the younger."

Rom.9.13 - As it is written, "Jacob I have loved, but Esau I have hated."

Rom.9.14 - What shall we say then? Is there unrighteousness with God? Certainly not!

Rom.9.15 - For He says to Moses, "I will have mercy on whomever I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whomever I will have compassion."

Rom.9.16 - So then it is not of him who wills, nor of him who runs, but of God who shows mercy.

Rom.9.17 - For the Scripture says to the Pharaoh, "For this very purpose I have raised you up, that I may show My power in you, and that My name may be declared in all the earth."

Rom.9.18 - Therefore He has mercy on whom He wills, and whom He wills He hardens.
