Hello there! Happy you could come by our graphic blog! As you may know, there are multiple positions you can have in this blog community!

A few are:

Viewers- Anyone who has, will and does view this blog is a viewer! They are equally as important as anyone else, even if they don't directly contribute to the blog, they still help the community grow!

Contributors- Jammers who send in graphics or help with the blog!

Contributors also have the option to send in their posts to be posted by one of the authors (if they don't have a Google account)!

Graphic Artists- Graphic Artists send in graphics so that they may be placed on a page for others to see and use with credit to them! Graphic Artists help bring in a healthy supply of new graphics for the public to use! Without them, we wouldn't have as many awesome graphics!

Designers- People who make custom banners, headers, signatures, advertisements, logos and graphics for viewers! They help add a creative atmosphere to the blog!

Authors- Authors posts some cool graphics, glitches and anything they want that is related to Animal Jam and appropriate!

To become a Graphic Artist on the AJGC...

If you would like to be a graphic artist on the Animal Jam Graphic Central, welcome aboard! You will have to send in 2–3 minimum graphics or cool sidebar graphics whether they are original, or found on other blogs with credit to the owner/creator each week. Graphic Artists also receive a blurb on our Graphic Artists/Designers! page as well.

To become a designer on the AJGC...

If you have a passion for creating banners, signatures or headers, a designer is certainly the job for you! As a designer, your username/hickname will be featured on the Graphic Artists/Designers!

page, and when someone requests a commission, I will choose one of the designers to create it using his/her creativity! Being a designer, there is no weekly requirement of customs, only the requirement of politeness and dedication to the clients. If more than 3 bad reports are sent in by clients, you will be temporarily removed from the designers board.

To become an author on the AJGC...

If you are accepted as an author, you have certain responsibilities. First of all, you will receive the permission to post on the AJGC, but this privilege can be removed if you abuse it. If you curse, use bad language, insult other jammers, plagiarize, spam, give unsafe information, scam, threaten other jammers and so on, your posts will be deleted and you will have your Author position removed.

The posting responsibilities of an author include:

- Make sure you use proper grammar. I don't mind you using emoticons like "XD" or ":)" and so on, nor do I mind you using the occasional "LOL". But please, please, PLEASE do not use too many texting abbreviations, and try to start all of your sentences with capital letters and end with proper punctuation, like periods, commas, question marks et cetera. I'm not going to be a huge stickler on the spelling though—as long as you take advantage of auto-correct!
- -You do not have to post daily—I want to have multiple authors who post on different days, not a few who are pressured to post every day. You can post whenever you want, and mainly about whatever you want, as long as you have a few graphics in the post as well that you either found on the Internet or made yourself.
- Plagiarism is a HUGE no-no. If you use a picture/graphic without credit more than three times, then you will have a temporary ban from posting. It's okay if you really didn't know that the picture belonged to someone,

but it is always a good idea to be sure. If you are searching for things on Google Images, it is a good idea to click the "Visit Page" to make sure that the page that the image is on is okay with you using it for your own purposes. If you aren't sure if they are okay with you using the image or not, just give credit to their blog. Better safe than sorry!

- Posting about scammers or hackers you find is okay, as long as they really ARE a scammer. If you haven't actually seen them scam anyone, just say that they were "acting suspiciously" or something along those lines. Accusing the innocent isn't kind, and I don't want them stumbling across your post and getting mad. If there is a known hacker or scammer out there that you'd like to make a post about, go ahead-but remember—this is a graphic blog, not a scamming and hacking blog. You can make the occasional awareness post for scammers and hackers, but you can't have every post you make be about that.
- -You can advertise your own blog or YouTube channel, but not in an obvious way. At the end of your post you can write "Check out my blog by clicking here!" or "My newest YouTube video can be viewed here!". But please refrain from saying "MY BLOG IS SO MUCH BETTER THAN THIS ONE, CHECK IT OUT BY CLICKING HERE HERE HERE HERE!!!" Or something like that.
- Have fun with it! You do not have to post the new updates unless I am not able to, and you can post whenever you want (within reason of course)! Spend your time interacting with viewers, commenting, chatting and having fun!

I hope I didn't frighten you guys or scare you away! These positions are always open, so be sure to send in your entry form soon!
