Program Management - includes program design and overseeing day to day program operations

## **General Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Support Drop-In Center Operations: greet and check in guests, manage shower and laundry queue, support meals services, support guests access to computers, etc.
- Support guest services including: process requests for vital documents (birth certificates, IDs, etc), provide housing and shelter referrals, and connecting individuals to services with a warm handoff
- Pair with Street Outreach Coordinators to walk Georgetown and connect with individuals on the streets
- Building meaningful relationship that support the informal support structure of socially isolated individuals

#### **Specific Deliverable(s)**:

- Manage the summer clothing distribution program, ensuring that all donated clothing that comes in gets to the guests who need it
- Summer clothing distribution program entails:
  - o Keeping inventory of existing and incoming clothing donations
  - o Maintaining an organized clothing closet so items are easily accessible to all staff
  - o Hosting a weekly clothing distribution so guests are able to select items they need
  - o Tracking items and sizes that are most commonly requested
  - o Offering ideas and opinions about sustainable ways to maintain structure and organization with clothing distribution at the conclusion of the internship
