NOTE – In order to graduate, students are required to complete a minimum of 42 hours from Harding courses numbered 3000-4999.

NOTE – HIST 11103 transfers as elective HIST hours. However, it will substitute for HIST 2100 when students complete the associates degree as part of this articulation agreement.

NOTE – ENGL 10203 transfers as elective ENG hours. However, it will substitute for ENG 2110 when students complete the associates degree as part of this articulation agreement.

NOTE – In order to graduate, students are required to complete a minimum of cumulative 120 hours.

NOTE – In order to graduate, students are required to complete a minimum of cumulative 60 hours from a four-year school.

NOTE – Students who have completed an Associates' Degree with the required coursework can enroll in the 2+2 program at Harding. Students who have not completed an Associates' Degree must complete all required coursework and a minimum of 60 hours of college credit to enroll.

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
