Educational Rights

Under the McKinney-Vento Act, homeless Youth and children have the right to

- receive a free, appropriate public education
- enroll in school immediately, even if lacking documents normally required for enrollment
- enroll in school and attend classes while the school gathers needed documents
- enroll in the local school; or continuing attending the school of origin (the school they attended when they permanently housed or the school in which they were last enrolled), according to each student's best interest
 - *if the school district believes that the school selected is not the student's best interest the district must provide the parent guardian or unaccompanied youth with a written explanation of its position and inform the parent, guardian, or youth of the right to appeal its decision
- receive transportation to and from the school of origin, if requested
- receive educational services comparable to those provided to other students, according to each student's needs.

Derechos educativos

Según la Ley McKinney-Vento, los jóvenes y niños sin hogar tienen derecho a

- recibir una educación pública gratuita y adecuada
- inscribirse en la escuela de inmediato, incluso si no tienen los documentos que normalmente se requieren para la inscripción
- inscribirse en la escuela y asistir a clases mientras la escuela reúne los documentos necesarios
- inscribirse en la escuela local; o continuar asistiendo a la escuela de origen (la escuela a la que asistían cuando vivían permanentemente o la escuela en la que estaban inscritos por última vez), de acuerdo con el mejor interés de cada estudiante
 - * si el distrito escolar cree que la escuela seleccionada no es lo mejor para el estudiante, el distrito debe proporcionar al padre, tutor o al joven no acompañado una explicación por escrito de su cargo e informar al padre, tutor o al joven del derecho a apelar su decisión
- recibir transporte hacia y desde la escuela de origen, si se solicita
- recibir servicios educativos comparables a los que se brindan a otros estudiantes, de acuerdo con las necesidades de cada estudiante.
