 - Querying the DB's and generating reports from MySQL directly?
- Use of different workflows for ingest
 - Different workflows depending on how well we know the material
 - e.g. At Kommunalförbundet Sydarkivera lots of materials come from municipalities, and from old systems, homegrown or custom built systems, not sure what we're going to get
 - Different workflows depending on the types of materials
 - Lots of pre-processing, before materials get to Archivematica
 - e.g. To capture certain types of info. from certain collections
 - Processing configs
 - Might run packages/ files through DROID before Archivematica
 - Workflows that involve purging information that is no longer used
 - Esp. important for running env's where space is limited or potentially costly
 - Can use different tools for finding duplicates, long file paths, and cleaning up the storage drive
 - Migration from DuraCloud to Coretex (sp?), running through Archivematica to utilize some of the automations that it does
 - Converting Word to PDF is not available in Archivematica Normalization options
 - Can do manual normalization or format migration, outside of Archivematica
- Large packages
 - Large can be large number of files, or large size overall
 - Q. Experiences with managing large packages?

- At UMichigan, one package had 44k files!
 - Ran for 3 Days
 - Found out that a second file ID process/ microservice was running, which slowed things down
 - Was able to stop the ingest mid-stream
- Large Size you can mitigate this with compute power, distribution of the workload;
- Large Number of Files this is harder to mitigate with compute power;
 - Solution to tar the files up as a single file and run them as one large file
 - 10k is an upper limit
- At UT-Austin, some packages with hundreds of thousands of files!
 - Bagging at the collection level, with millions of files in the collection
 - Largest AIP 6TB
 - Automation Tools getting stuck w/ 150GB package

 - AIC Search only works if you have this column enabled
- Preingest actions to make transfer and submission easier
 - Python Scripts
 - MediaConc run this to examine the materials, so we know if they can be ingested/ if they pass or fail the policy, improperly formed bag,
 - Normalization actions e.g. migrate formats before ingest
 - *In many cases, it works better to run scripts and tools before ingest, rather than try to integrate these tools into Archivematica or get Archivematica to do these tasks
