ADVICE ON ARREST:

Say 'NO COMMENT' to all police questions during casual chats, 'booking in' & interviews. At the police station you may wish to give your name, address and date of birth to speed your release. If asked your nationality you must give it. For your protection and that of other people don't answer further questions. Please let me know if you know of anyone else to add to this!

Do not accept a **CAUTION** without advice from a recommended solicitor. This is admission of responsibility and goes on the police national computer.

You have the right to **FREE LEGAL ADVICE** at the police station. Duty solicitors don't always have experience with protest law we recommend asking the police to contact one of the following:

- What to do if ICE comes to your door
 - Do not open doors: ICE cannot come in without a signed warrant by a criminal court judge. They can only come in if you let them in.
 - Remain silent: ICE can use anything you say against you in your immigration case so claim your right to remain silent ("I plead the fifth amendment and choose to remain silent")
