

2 – 3 main characters in the book? Give some information about them so that your reader 'knows' them.

**The plot** – Describe the setting and what the story is about. (**DO NOT COPY** – write it in your own words.) **Prove** that you have read the entire book.

## Book Task Assignment Grade 9 - Passover 2017

**Page 2:** 10%

Write a **letter** to the author explaining why you liked or didn't like the book. Relate to two or three specific incidents in the story. You may explain how these incidents added to your understanding of the story, or what you learned about the character(s) involved through them. This should be 100 – 120 words – 4 paragraphs.

**Page 3: Creative** - Choose from one of the following: 25%

- A. Draw a picture from the story.
- B. Write an original poem / song about the story (include details).
- C. Create a original presentation telling the story
- D. Create an original advertisement for the book.
- E. Build something original that is connected to the story
- F. Make an original movie trailer
- G. Anything you think will show the main point of the story ask me first, please!

Part 2: In this part you will <u>talk</u> about the story for 2 minutes; what you liked/didn't like and about the work you did for the creative part. You can either speak to the class and present your work or you can send me a video of yourself speaking. YOU MUST LOOK at the camera when you speak (you may not read from ANY pre-written text).

This is 50% of the grade.
