

WE ARE ONE 2024, 21 DAY FASTING AND PRAYER GUIDE (January 8th-January 28th)

THEME: "BETTER" - A Special Time of **Worship, Prayer** and **Fasting**.

During this season of renewed worship, focused prayer and fasting as a church family, we will seek the Lord to be "BETTER" in several areas (health, relationships, finances, wellness, vocation/Spiritual gifts). We're believing God for answered prayer and direction for specific needs, declaring our dependence on God in every area of our lives, asking for forgiveness for our sins and standing in the gap for our families, friends and nation. We will also be praying for our revived commitment to the Great Commission, inviting a fresh Presence of God in our lives and church family. We would love for you to join with us as we gather in one spirit to pray toward heaven for "BETTER!"

At We Are One Christian Fellowship, we are proclaiming a church-wide fast for 21 days beginning Sunday, January 7, 2024. The primary spiritual goal of fasting is to draw nearer to God. The idea is always to sacrifice something, and if and when you start to think about your sacrifice, turn your thoughts to God and pray. Biblical fasting always has to do with eliminating distractions for a spiritual purpose; it hits the reset button of our soul and renews us from the inside out making us "BETTER." What areas of your life do you want to be better? Because fasting rejuvenates and empowers us to celebrate the goodness and mercy of God, leads us into a deeper worship experience with God, and prepares our hearts for greater service and all the good things God desires to bring into our lives. When we put the things of God first in our lives, other things fall into Divine Order.

WHAT IS BIBLICAL FASTING? A biblical fast can be defined as simply abstaining from food for spiritual purposes. It was encouraged and expected by Jesus that believers would fast (Matt. 6:17-18, Matt. 9:15). Many abstain from food, television, social media, and other forms of personal sacrifice during this time and instead spend that time with an extra emphasis on drawing closer to God. What makes this time of fasting rich is using the time to pray, meditate, read the Bible and worship God. Simply said, if fasting is not coupled with prayer, Bible reading, worship, and abstaining from food it is simply a diet.

PREPARING YOUR FAST

- **Prepare yourself to be better Spiritually:** Remember the very foundation of fasting and prayer is repentance and renewed dedication and worship to God. Do not underestimate spiritual opposition from Satan and the flesh (Gal. 5:16,17). Our worship to God (both individually and corporately) will be a central focus of our fast.
- **Prepare yourself to be better physically:** Fasting requires reasonable precautions. Consult your physician if necessary. Drink plenty of water and rest as much as your schedule will permit.
- **Be sure to set your own personal objectives to be better as well.** Is it for spiritual renewal, for guidance, for healing, for the resolution of problems, for special grace to handle a difficult situation? Ask the Holy Spirit to clarify His leading and objectives for your prayer fast. This will enable you to pray and worship more specifically and strategically.

- **BELIEVE GOD FOR “BETTER” IN EVERY AREA OF YOUR LIFE (HEALTH, RELATIONSHIPS, FINANCES, WELLNESS, VOCATION/SPIRITUAL GIFTS).** SINCERELY HUMBLE YOURSELF BEFORE THE LORD IN WORSHIP: REPENT, PRAY, SEEK GOD’S FACE, AND CONSISTENTLY MEDITATE ON HIS WORD. YOU WILL EXPERIENCE A HEIGHTENED AWARENESS OF HIS PRESENCE. YOU WILL ALSO FEEL MENTALLY, SPIRITUALLY, AND PHYSICALLY REFRESHED. THE LORD WILL GIVE YOU FRESH, NEW SPIRITUAL INSIGHTS AND YOUR CONFIDENCE AND FAITH IN GOD WILL BE STRENGTHENED.

21 DAY DIETARY GUIDE

WEEK 1: No caffeine, sweets, junk food, or sodas.

21 DAY PRAYER GUIDE

Sunday, January 7th - KICKOFF

Day 1 – Monday, January 8th.

Scripture:

So then FAITH COMES BY HEARING, and hearing by the word of God. - Romans 10:17 (KJV)

Confession:

Faith comes when I hear (believe) Gods Word. I meditate upon the Word, and my faith grows to receive the grace, strength, and miracle I need.

Today’s Challenge: Have fun and be a blessing to those around you in 3 different ways today!

Prayer for Monday – Your Heart & Soul Yielded & Submitted to God.

Luke 10:27 NKJV “So He answered and said, ‘You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your strength, and with all your mind, and your neighbor as yourself.’”

Declare your complete dependence on God in every area of your life. Draw near to Him by spending time in His Word each day. Be willing to change and adjust anything that He asks of you. Allow the Holy Spirit to help you bring your mind, will & emotions under control as you talk to God daily in prayer. Go for it! Enjoy your time with God today!

Day 2 – Tuesday, January 9th.

Scripture:

Confession:

Prayer for Tuesday – For Your Personal Path & Plan.

Proverbs 3:5–6 NLT “Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek His will in all you do, and He will show you which path to take.”

Pray for God to direct your decisions and give you knowledge and understanding of His will and plan for the year. Pray for God to show you how to grow in every area of your life. Expect His grace to empower you so that His peace can rule in your heart in every situation. Determine to walk in love and ask Him to help you live a life that honors and pleases Him.

Day 4 – Thursday, January 11th.

Scripture:

And the glory which you gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one:
St. John 21:22

Today's Challenge: Memorize our Church Vision: Encounter God-Equip and Empower People-Engage the Community.

Note: Tomorrow is Early Bird Friday - That means you will wake up an hour early and pray in the morning! Don't forget to set your alarm clocks tonight to get up early!

Prayer for Thursday – Praying for Your Church.

Colossians 1:10,11 AMPC "That you (we) may walk (live and conduct yourselves) in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him and desiring to please Him in all things, bearing fruit in every good work and steadily growing and increasing in and by the knowledge of God [with fuller, deeper, and clearer insight, acquaintance, and recognition]."

Romans 12:4, 5 "For as we have many members in one body, but all the members do not have the same function, so we, being many, are one body in Christ, and individually members of one another.

Pray that, together we would fulfill God's vision. And together that we would be a light in the world that would show the love of God in powerful and tangible ways so that the world would take notice and come running to God for salvation.

Scripture:

I abide in Him. I live in Him. He is the vine—I am the branch. The vine is in the branch—and the branch is in the vine. His Life—the Life of God— is in me. His nature —the Love nature—is in me. Just as blood flows through my natural body, His Life flows through my inner man. I will let that Life and Love dominate me.

Today's Challenge: Wake up an hour early and pray today! Remember, we told you yesterday to set your alarm clocks before you went to bed. If you didn't then take some extra time to worship and enjoy Jesus today! We will do this again next Thursday!

Prayer for Friday – Praying for Your Community, Outreaches and Reaching the Lost.

Proverbs 11:30 NKJV "The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life, and he who wins souls is wise."

Matthew 9:37–38 NIV "Then He said to His disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful, but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into His harvest field.'"

Confession:

By His stripes I was healed! God's Word tells me I was healed almost 2000 years ago by His stripes. If I was healed, then I am healed. Healing belongs to me because I am in Christ.

Today's Challenge: Be a big blessing to one of your friends today!

Prayer for Saturday – Praying For Your Nation.

I Timothy 2:1-4 NIV “I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people — for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. This is good, and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.”

Pray for a mighty spiritual awakening to sweep across your nation. Pray specifically for your leaders to acknowledge God and submit to His righteousness; that they would have His wisdom and walk in it for every area of government. Pray that God would cause your country to be a light to all nations and a testimony of God’s power and love to the world.

Day 7 – Sunday, 14th.

Scripture:

Confession:

Today’s Challenge: Text 3 people with a word of hope and encouragement.

Prayer for Sunday – Praying for Your Local Government

I Timothy 2:1-4 “Therefore I exhort first of all that supplication, prayers, and intercessions, and giving of thanks be made for all men, for kings and all who are in authority, that we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.

Proverbs 21:1 NKJV “The king’s (leader’s) heart is in the hand of the Lord, like the rivers of water; He turns it wherever He wishes.”

Pray for Your Local Leaders: Praying for your local legislature, court system and all the schools. As I give, it is given unto me, good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over. Thank you, Jesus! Father, I know that you love a cheerful giver and that you give seed to the sower. Anoint me to sow more bountifully into your Kingdom and into the lives of others this year.

Today’s Challenge: Increase your giving in these three areas: Time, Mercy, and Finances.

Scripture:

Confession:

Today’s Challenge: Turn your TV off this evening and spend some time with God!

Prayer for Sunday – Pray to be a “BETTER” example of loving one another.
