We design

Now that we've received your document, we are going to take this to our design team who will take your specs and vision and bring it to life. This might take up to a week, so sit tight and we will reach out within a week with your first mockup.

You confirm

After receiving the first mockup from your Fancy Sports Rep, look it over and let us know if you want anything changed. You are limited to only one revision in the process, so be sure to Fancy Sports comprehensive and detailed with your feedback that you send to your Fancy Sports Rep.

We re-design

After receiving your last set of feedback, our team will go through it all and implement the changes you've requested. This can take generally anywhere between 1-4 days depending on how large the changes are. After we have completed the final design, we will send it to you for a final confirmation.

Ordering and Production

Now that the design is sorted, your Fancy Sports Rep will guide you through the Ordering Process and place your design and order into production when ready.
