

Appendix H – Financial Structure & Host Chapter Contributions

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Our Purpose

The Johns–Culpepper Family Reunion is NOT a profit-making organization. All funds collected support:

- Reunion activities
- Family programs
- Scholarships
- Recognition of important family milestones
- Long-term organizational growth

Registration Fees

Except for the Cruise Host Chapter, each host chapter assesses a registration fee based on estimated hosting costs.

Registration Fees Cover:

- Venue costs
- Food & catering
- Decorations & supplies
- Local planning expenses

Cruise Host Chapter

The Cruise Host Chapter does NOT assess a registration fee. Cruise lodging, food, and activities are included in the cruise price and paid directly to the cruise line by attendees.

Additional Fundraising

- Offset reunion costs
- Reduce financial burden on attendees
- Strengthen local planning efforts

Host Chapter Contributions (Based on Net Profit)

Each hosting chapter shall donate a percentage of their proceeds as a financial assessment to the Johns Culpepper Family organization (Article IX Chapter Fees, Sec 1).

Tiered Percentage Model

Host chapters will contribute 0% if net profits are \$0–\$100

Contribute 25% if net profits \$101–\$500

Contribute 40% if net profits are Over \$500

This provision ensures financial fairness, sustainability of the organization, continued support for scholarships and family milestones, and strong host chapters with adequate working funds.
