

Medical Assistant Post-Enrollment Requirements

Toward the end of the Medical Assistant Program, students must complete the requirements below before enrolling in these courses:

- TEMA 1900 Medical Assistant Externship I*
- TEMA 1910 Medical Assistant Externship II*

Screenings:

- Background Check:** Completed through [Tiburon](#).
- Drug Screening:** Completed through [Cedar City Workmed](#).
- TB:** One of the following:

2-Step TB test

Visit 1: Place the first PPD **Visit 2:** 48-72 hours later, the PPD is read. **Visit 3:** 1-3 weeks after Visit 1, the second PPD is placed. **Visit 4:** 48-72 hours later, the final PPD is read.

or

QuantiFERON-TB Gold (QFT)

QuantiFERON-TB Gold (QFT) is a simple blood test that aids in the detection of Mycobacterium tuberculosis, the bacteria which causes tuberculosis (TB).

Immunizations:

- Hepatitis B**
- Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis Tdap**
- Varicella**
- Measles, Mumps, Rubella MMR**
- Influenza** (Must be current flu season immunization.)
