# NEVADA AREA COUNCIL 2026 MEMBERSHIP PLAN

## **SUMMARY:**

In 2026, the Nevada area Council will focus on:

- Build on school relationships which have driven Fall Recruitment success in 2023 and 2024, deploying a dedicated Membership Growth Executive to reach out to the many schools that we have not yet developed relationships with.
- Execute a Dynamic Recruiting Campaign empowering our units and families to recruit throughout the year.
- Offer a “Gold Card” of \$50 retail value this Spring as an incentive for existing Cubs and Scouts to recruit a buddy.
- Continue to build new units, emphasizing new Cub Scout Packs to provide a base for continued membership growth and to serve more local schools.
- Improve retention by developing a cadence of calling new Scouting families to find out if they are getting the program that they deserve.

**NAC MEMBERSHIP BACKGROUND**

The last eight years of membership effort in the Nevada Area Council has been dominated by the need to combat the triple impact of the loss of the LDS Church, the impact of Covid 19 on Cub Scout membership and the dramatic rise in price of National Registration Fees coupled with ending the ability to prorate those fees.

A focus since 2023 on establishing relationships with and recruiting from Elementary Schools has achieved just one year of very modest growth in Traditional Membership. The National Council policy of no longer allowing the proration of membership fees effectively priced many families out of giving Scouting a try. This fact was confirmed locally in late October of 2023 when the successful closure rate of recruitment events jumped from 25% to 65% as soon as Council V.P. of Membership Laif Meidell began covering a significant portion of the National Registration Fees for new Cub Scout families. The change to individual registration renewals and extending registration drops into 2025 have added to retention challenges by effectively pushing two years of drops into one calendar year. National’s attempt to make up for this by retroactively adjusting the 2024 membership numbers erased that year’s Membership Growth as well.

- Establish an Educator Impact event in the Washoe County School District to strengthen the relationship at both the School District Administration and local Elementary school levels.
3. Long Term Objectives
- Achieve a consistent 3% growth rate annually.
  - Achieve net unit growth per District of 1 new Pack, 1 new Troop, 1 new Crew, 1 and 1 New Post.
  - Become local schools' "go to" organization for community partnership.
  - Add one new Venturing Crew in each district annually.
  - Add six new Exploring Posts across the Council annually.
  - Recruit and train a Council Membership Chair (2025).
  - Organize and run a council-wide recruitment workshop (2025).
  - Organize and run a council-wide retention workshop (2026).

### Membership Analysis:

#### Available Youth and Opportunities to Grow Scouting

The Total Available Youth to join Cub Scouting (our entry level program for new members) in the Nevada Area Council is just over 61,400 young people and growing. There is room to add units, and new members everywhere in the Council in all programs. Particularly underserved areas for Zephyr District include Zip Codes 89506 in Reno, and 89436 in Sparks. For Sierra Nevada/Great Basin, Zip Codes 89521 in Reno, plus Elko, Fallon and particularly 89706 (Carson City) have the most room for growth.

The Zip Codes with the largest number of unserved youth from ethnicities that Scouting has traditionally struggled serving are:

- 89502 South Reno around the Airport and Midtown to Hidden Valley  
3,000 Hispanic Youth and 240 African American youth
- 89431 Sparks, Around the marina and central part of the city  
2,800 Hispanic Youth, and 220 African American youth
- 89506 Lemmon/Gold Valleys  
2,700 Hispanic Youth and 190 African American youth

### Assumptions

- Total Available Youth will continue to increase, especially in the greater Reno area.
- The price point of registration is still important. We can project a recruitment event closure rate of 20% to 25% at \$145, or 65% to 75% at \$85.
- A dedicated Membership Executive can help us increase membership by improving school access through individual visits.
- We must recruit more District level volunteers to lead and support our Membership Efforts.
- We must improve our retention efforts.
- We must continue to increase our public visibility by increased marketing, and the continued growth of the Reno Adventure Hike, and our public facing BB Gun Ranges, and Pinewood Derby events.

### Plan for Membership Growth

#### A. Increased School Access

- A dedicated Membership Executive, Matthew Ball starts on March 16 and will be tasked with starting relationships with previously unserved schools.
- Scout Executive visits with Superintendents and a possible teacher impact event may produce increased school access and cooperation.

#### B. Emphasis on both Spring Recruiting and Year-Round Dynamic Recruiting

- Laif Meidell is introducing a \$50 value Council Gold card as an incentive for Scout families to recruit a new Scout.
- With the help of our Membership Executive, we plan to execute a Spring Recruitment similar to what we do in the Fall, using Day Camp as part of the invitation to experience Scouting.

**C. Tactical Improvements to our Fall Recruitment Campaign**

- Additional manpower available from our new Membership Executive will help.
- We will add wristbands to our tool kit and use them along with flyers where applicable.
- We will tie the early part of the campaign even more strongly to the Reno Adventure Hike and attempt to use it not only as a Deliver the Promise event, but also as its own Recruitment Event, with youth registered on sight.

**D. Retention**

- Execute a more disciplined plan with AOLs tracked by name what Troop they plan on joining.
- Develop a cadence of calling new families within 30 days of joining to check on their first unit experiences in the program.

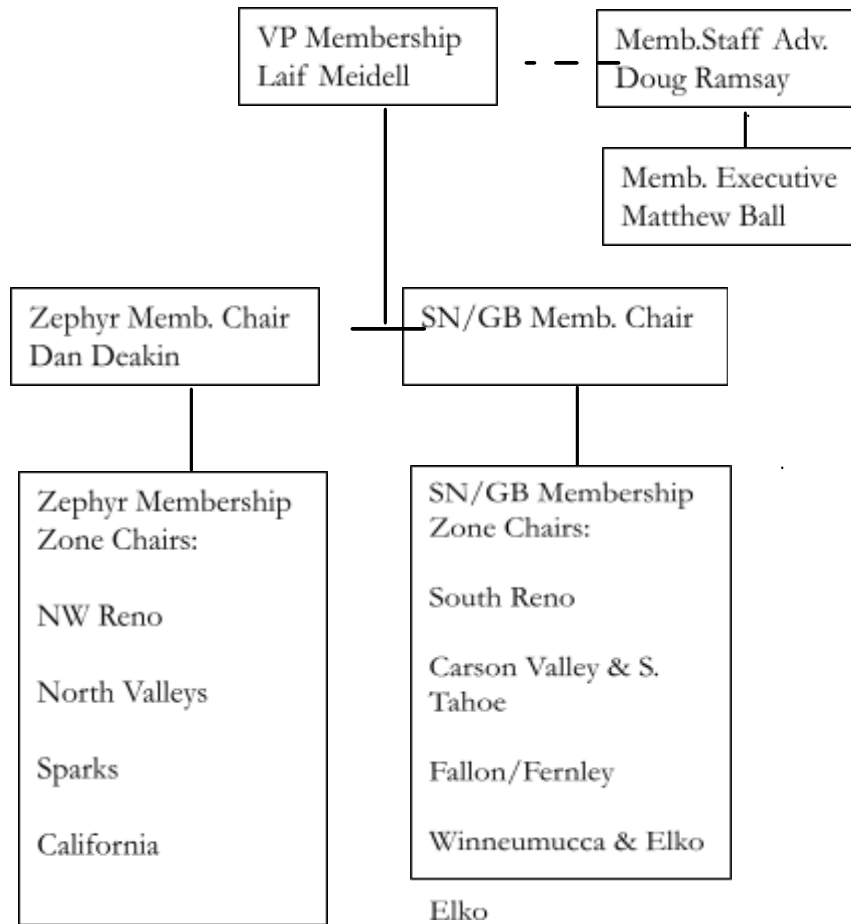
**E. New Unit Production**

- Take advantage of the National Exploring Explosion 3.0 and the current interest in Fire Departments chartering Fire Posts.
