# International Gymkhana GP competition regulation

### 1. General rules

- 1. All sportsmen are allowed to participate without age restrictions
- 2. All types of motorcycles and scooters are allowed
- 3. Tyre warmers are allowed
- 4. Obscene language is not allowed.

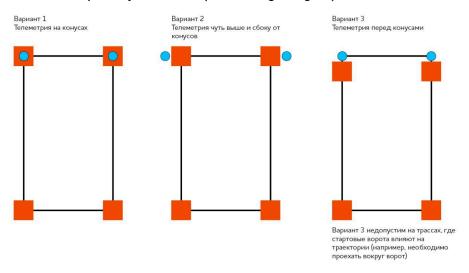
## 2. Stage courses

- 1. Course of the stage is being choosing by voting on the website <a href="gymkhana-cup.com">gymkhana-cup.com</a>. Only registered members can vote. During the voting, member can choose only one course. Changing of the selected course after the voting is not possible.
  - If the vote has not been started, the track is chosen by the administration.
- 2. Courses that were used for competitions or trainings cannot be used for voting.
- 3. Anyone can draw his own course and send it for voting. You can send it to gymkhana.cup@gmail.com.
- 4. Course requirements:
  - Max width: less than 20m, including start/finish gates;
  - Max length: less than 40 meters, including start/finish gates.
  - Element "Mirror" is not allowed.

## 3. Confirmation of the results

- 1. For result confirmation, it is necessary to send a video that meets following requirements:
  - Start and finish of the ride are clearly visible. In the beginning of the video, rider should be in the start zone, with foot on the ground, without crossing start line. Start and finish of the ride should be recorded on the video. Rider shouldn't touch cones during start or finish.
  - Whole course, start/finish gates, and rider should be clearly visible during
    ride. All the cones should be clearly visible, the athletes are passing by. If
    the cones overlap in the video, the result will be rejected. In this case, the
    cones that are not involved at a particular moment in time may disappear
    from the frame (that is, it is not forbidden to zoom in on the video or
    "quide" the camera behind the athlete)
  - There is a route time.
  - The athlete must be in the frame all the time, leaving even for a split second is unacceptable
  - Time of the ride should be also shot on the camera. This time should be caught with electronic telemetry. Time results, that caught on mobile

- phone, manual chronograph or superimposed in video editors will not be accepted.
- After a complete stop at the finish gate, the participant must record the result on the camera without interrupting the video
- Video should be named in the following way: Gymkhana GP 2022 stage1 (or other number of the stage) / Surname Motorcycle / heat 1 (or other number of the heat)
  - For example: Gymkhana GP 2022 stage1 / Haruhiko Tsujiie SUZUKI GSX R1000 / heat1
- Amount of heats is unlimited. You can record and send any heat, which improves your time.
- 2. Video should be placed on one of the following sites:
  - YouTube
  - Yandex disk
  - Google disk
  - VK Видео
  - RuTube
- 3. Requirements for video quality:
  - Video should have resolution that not less than 480p
  - Video should be clear, with good view of the rider, his motorbike, cones and his path. Video should be recorded in the daytime, or with good lightning.
  - Judges can deny result, if they cannot clearly check ride for mistakes.
- 4. Requirements for telemetry installation:
  - Telemetry should be located at a height of 300 to 550 mm
  - Telemetry must be located exactly on the start line. It is unacceptable to move telemetry forward of the starting gate.
  - Starting goal lines must be drawn on the asphalt. In the absence of a lines, a +3sec penalty be added (for leaving the goal)



# 4. Rules

- 1. Course should be made of sport or road cones.
- 2. Cone height:
  - For riders of C3 class and higher 450mm and higher
  - For riders of N...D1 300mm and higher

- 3. Cones can be extended to the required height, provided that the height of the lower cone is not less than 300 mm. The diameter of the extended part at the top point must be at least 35 mm, i.e. the extended part must imitate a cone. For incorrect cone sizes, the penalty is +1 second to the time
- 4. In case you take part in competitions on the gymkhana-cup site for the first time and do not have a class, a class may be assigned to you by the site administration based on your performances in other competitions, or you will be assigned a class N.
- 5. If you are in class C3 and above with cones below 450mm a penalty of +1 second to the time.
- 6. For classes A, B, C1, C2 it is not allowed to use bottles, cups and any other items instead of cones. The minimum allowable height of the cones is 300mm. The use of smaller cones is a disqualification.
- 7. Results are accepting with rounding up to hundredths of seconds. If your timer records time up to thousandths result will be rounded up according to mathematic rules.

#### 8. Penalties:

#### 1 second

- Hit or knock down cone
- Take foot out of the peg and touch the ground

#### 3 seconds

- Put foot on the ground and turn around (excepts FOOT OK zone)
- Walking with foot on the ground
- Start or finish ride with motorbike outside of start/finish gate.
- No start/finish gate lines

#### Disqualification

- Skip element
- Drive through the finish gate without stopping
- Video recording does not allow you to verify that there are no errors.
- Non-compliance with the rules of section 3

#### 9. Penalties explanations:

- Touching the ground during ride with any part of the bike will not cause any penalty.
- If rider falls inside of start/finish gates, but motorcycle is inside of the start/finish zone and it stopped no penalty will be applied.
- Motorbike outside of start/finish gate it is a situation, when any part of
  the motorbike touches the ground outside of start/finish zone. Start and
  finish should be performed in the way, when contact patches of the both
  motorbike wheels are inside of the start/finish zone.
- If some parts of the bike, that are not touching the ground, are outside of start/finish zone no penalty will be applied.
- Rider can also be outside of the start/finish zone (for example, when falls from the bike during finishing). In this case no penalty will be applied.
