GOAL: Call from a list of 15,000 progressive voters who may not vote—80% of whom are Black—and ID their support for Cheri Beasley for U.S. Senate, Lucy Inman and Sam Ervin for State Supreme Court, and Valerie Jordan for State House. We'll be calling rural voters in Northeast North Carolina. We'll be helping Democrats keep control of the U.S. House and Senate, win races for the state legislature and judgeships, and preserve reproductive, voting and civil rights in North Carolina.

New Phone Bankers:

- 1. If you don't already have an account with OpenVPB, <u>follow these instructions to create</u> one, starting with Step 2.
- 2. Then sign up to attend an initial training/call session with All In for NC, any Sunday at 6 pm.
- 3. Once you've been trained, you can make these calls any day of the week. Contact Dana at leanleftcvt@gmail.com in order to receive the phone bank link or sign up to attend PowerHour on Sundays 3-5 pm if you'd like to call with other Lean Left volunteers.

Election Dates:

- Early Voting: Thursday, Oct 20 Saturday, Nov. 5
- Election Day: Tuesday, November 8th
- If voters have questions about mail-in ballots or their Early Voting location, have them call the NC Voter Assistance Hotline at 1-833-VOTE4NC (good for people who can't navigate websites and for people with detailed questions).
- You can also refer people to <u>iwillvote.com</u> to check their early vote locations

Since our initial goal is to get through as many numbers as quickly as possible in order to clean up the lists, please don't leave a message yet. Later, when wrong numbers and disconnecteds are no longer an issue, we can leave a short message to help with candidate name recognition.

I'm reaching out to you today to make sure you're aware that we have a critical mid-term election coming up November 8th, and our candidate for U.S. Senate, Cheri Beasley, wants to know which issues you would like her to address when she gets elected. I would be happy to share your thoughts with her.
Will you be supporting Cheri Beasley in the upcoming U.S. Senate Election? IF YES
Fantastic! May we also count on your support for Sam Ervin and Lucy Inman, our Democratic candidates for the Supreme Court? (If they don't know names, suggest they "Search for Sam, Look for Lucy" when they go to vote.)

Great! I hope we can count on your support for Valerie Jordan, the Democratic candidate running for the State Senate?

And Howard Hunter, the Democratic candidate for the State House in your district?

Thank you so much for your support. Will you consider volunteering to help elect Democratic candidates up and down the ballot?

TIPS

If voter's concern is inflation: "I agree that's essential. Are you aware that Cheri's opponent voted AGAINST the Inflation Reduction Act?" [can shut down accusations toward Biden/Democrats since Budd voted with other Republicans against doing anything about inflation]
