Absolutely stunning is what Moors have left in this country. The **Great Mosque of Cordoba** is one of the most visited sights by tourists, the other of course being **Granada's Alhambra** which is perfectly conserved in its original condition. The Spanish Moors created a style of their own that differs in many aspects from their traditional architecture which you may find in Africa and introduced several novelties. This style is called **Caliphal** style.

The Christians who lived in Muslim territory were called *Mozarabes*, and so is called their particular architectonical style which combines Visigothic construction technics and caliphal style. After the country was reconquered from the Muslims, Moorish architects who stayed developed another new style combining their traditional architecture with **Romanesque** and **Gothic** elements, the *Mudejar* style.
