Target Individual Thomas Brillo, head of a small consumptive resurrectionist group (TO-391 "Marrow Breathers") is currently returning to Cincinnati after a meeting with an Unaware criminal organization.

Agents have spent the last week stationed in Mt. Orab, Ohio, waiting for Brillo to come north on U.S. Route 68. Referring to this as "the most boring week of my life" and "worse than the monsters" in after-action reports will be met with disciplinary action.

Brillo is expected to turn west on Old Ohio Highway 32 / West Main Street. He may or may not stop in Mt. Orab.

Agents must:

- 1) Capture Thomas Brillo, alive, for interrogation.
- 2) Utterly destroy Brillo's car, a Fiat 126p. I can guarantee that it is faster than whatever you have, and Brillo isn't driving it.

Killing or capturing other members of the Marrow Breathers is nonpriority. They outnumber you.

The Rest of the Thing

Thomas Brillo is pallid, balding, spongy. He can sustain 4 Serious Wounds without dying, and weapon rolls of 6 only give him a Serious Wound. This is due to his years-long habit of vaping ghosts. He will almost certainly surrender when his car is immobilized or destroyed - better to try and break out when there *aren't* half a dozen gunmen staring at him.

His car has a flaming skeletal *thing* under the hood, and if Brillo is removed or incapacitated, will drive on its own. Its self-driving is *predatory* - it will leap off the road to hit pedestrians, agents, and small animals. It will, in fact, drive directly into Mt. Orab and start trying to kill people, punching its hands and arms out from the engine compartment to make melee attacks against those it can't just run over.

The Fiat is the second of three cars in the convoy (the others being uninteresting, unmentionable mid-2000s sedans). It contains Brillo and his favorite goon, Mr. (no first name) Fisk. Mr. Fisk's skin visibly roils - if killed or Seriously Wounded, his skeleton bursts out of his skin, on fire, and attacks as a flying maelstrom of bones. He is armed with a revolver, just like Brillo.

Both other cars contain 3 rifle and grenade-armed goons.

The skeleton tornado can fly, and melee attacks at a +1. Every time it kills someone, it vacuums out all their bones and gets an additional +1 to its melee attacks.

Maps of Mt. Oreb are readily available online. This link to Google Maps will bring you to the intersection of Route 68 and Main Street. The convoy drives down Route 68 at 60, then comes to a stop to turn left onto West Main Street. If all goes well, they then drive off at normal highway speeds till Cincinnati.
