



Student Parking Information

Parking on campus is a privilege and parking permits are required. Permit stickers must be visibly displayed on the front windshield of any car parked in the parking lot.

WHS charges a \$20 fee for student parking permits. This fee must be paid before a parking permit may be issued. Students only need to pay this fee once, and will keep their parking permit for the duration of the time that they are students at WHS.

If students get a new/different vehicle, they should submit a new form with the vehicle information.

A new permit sticker will be issued, but a new fee will not be assessed.

Parking permits can be obtained in the 2nd floor main office during advisory and lunches.

Waterford Public Schools assumes no liability for loss or damage to cars parked on campus.

Students must park in the designated areas ONLY.

Seniors can park in the “Senior Only” lot next to the tennis courts.

Juniors/Seniors can park in the upper lot (closest to Rope Ferry Road).

There is NO student parking during the school day in the following areas:

- The overflow lot near the football field and bus lot
- The horseshoe outside the field house
- The faculty lots (*upper level by bus entrance or lower level by main entrance*)
- The Bus lot, Friendship School lot, etc.
- In fire lanes, beside sidewalks or on the grass



Students parking outside assigned areas during school hours will be directed to move their vehicle to an appropriate area and may be subject to school discipline. Repeat offenders will lose campus parking privileges.

Students who park without a permit, do not display their permit, park in areas that are not permitted or drive in a dangerous or reckless manner through our parking lot will be subject to school discipline and risk losing their parking privileges.
